Choice of third language for students moving to S1 in 2016/2017

Dear Parents and students of P5,

In S1 which all students begin a third language, known as their L3, **which is compulsory until S5**. Now is the time for them to consider which language they would like to study. We advise that your child consults with his teachers and considers any future career ideas he may already have.

In principle all EU languages are possible, but a minimum of 7 students is required for a course to run.

We therefore ask you to make a first, second and third choice.

- The first and second choices may be any EU language.
- The third choice must be Dutch, English, French, German, Italian or Spanish.
- Before ticking, we strongly recommend you to read carefully other information on our webpage about organisation of studies in the EE system <http://www.eeb4.be/fr/node/14>. For the general rules of the European Schools visit <http://eursc.org/>

In S1 students have a minimum of 33 periods and maximum 35 periods depending of the options.

Parents of category 1 and 2 **Irish pupils** may also elect for their children to study **Irish as ONL** (Other National Language). If you intend your child to study Irish this should also be indicated below. Please note this is extra to you choice of L3. This could cause the loss of lunchtime, or include P9 (15:05- 15:55) in the student's timetable.
