**Choice of options for students moving to S2 in 2016/2017**

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Dear Parents and students of S1,

- In S2 your child can choose a Latin as an optional beginner course of 2 weekly periods.
- If chosen in S2 this course will be obligatory continued in S3 as a 2 periods option. **Students with Latin in their curriculum in S1 will not be able to ask IT in S3**; IT will be proposed again as an option from S4.
