- The Intensive Support Assistant's role is to assist pupils with Special Educational Needs in their every day school routine.
- The Intensive Support Assistant will be involved in the special support given to the pupil and the follow-up of this support.
- The Intensive Support Assistant will work in collaboration and close communication with class teacher
- The Intensive Support Assistant informs the Management and the families regularly of the educational improvements
- The Intensive Support Assistant will participate in school activities and meetings
