Material list

Please make sure your child has everything for the first day of school and label everything.

- A large pencil case
- HB Pencils (at least 10-12)
- Pencil sharpener (with a container to catch the shavings)
- Full set of colouring pencils (at least 10 different colours)
- Full set of felt-tipped pens (at least 10 different colours)
- One interchangeable Bic biro (one pen with red, green, blue and black inks)
- A small pair of scissors
- Pritt-Stick style glue sticks (Pack of 3)
- A small set of watercolours (at least 10 different colours) Its worth spending the money on a good quality brand (Staedtler)
- 30cm transparent plastic ruler (not flexible or foldable)
- At least ten whiteboard pens
- A whiteboard and whiteboard eraser
- A large zip-lock bag big enough to hold the whiteboard and markers and eraser
- A large zip-lock bag big enough to hold A4 folders (for homework)
- Tin whistle in D (please ask if you're unsure what to get - Irish parents can usually help source these for a very reasonable price)

For the start of the school year, please organise these resources in the following way:

1. A pencil case containing some pencils, the pencil sharpener, the colouring pencils, the interchangeable biro, a pair of scissors, one glue stick
2. A zip-lock bag containing the whiteboard, whiteboard eraser and some whiteboard markers.
3. The remaining zip-lock bag will be for reading books, the agenda, reading records and homework.
4. The remaining resources will be stored in school so that your child has everything they need throughout the year. Please put these into a labelled carrier bag and give it to the class teacher **on the evening of your class meeting in the first week**. This ensures that the children turn up for school only with what they need to get started.
