# Music project

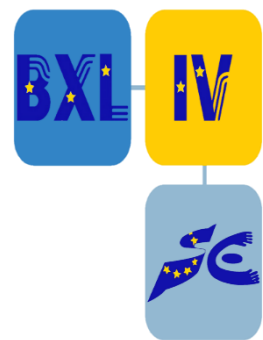


In s1-s3, the music course is **mandatory**. The pupils can choose to take part in the **music project**. This implies:

**3 (choir) or 4 (instruments)** music periods per week **instead of 2**. All periods take place **during school hours**.

The music project is based on **practical learning**. Learning how to play an instrument or sing **(strings, winds or choir)**

Pupils in the music project will at the same time cover the contents of the official syllabus.



# Who can participate?

- Any pupil who already plays a string, brass or woodwind instrument at any level.
- Any pupil that is motivated enough to learn to play a string, brass or woodwind instrument.
- Any pupil who likes singing (choir)

Absolute beginners may need to take extra instrument lessons (possibly organized by APEEE) in the school or outside.

# Music project (choir)



2 + 1

The music courses (**MUS-X**) will involve choir practice and will be taught by the school music teachers

A specific course of choir practice (**A11-X**) will be added. It will be taught by one of music teachers.

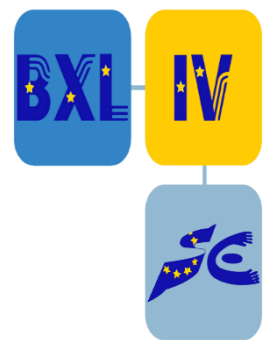
# Music project (instruments)



2 + 2

The music courses will involve instrumental ensembles rehearsals separated in wind (**MUS-W**) and string (**MUS-S**) groups and will be taught by the school music teachers.

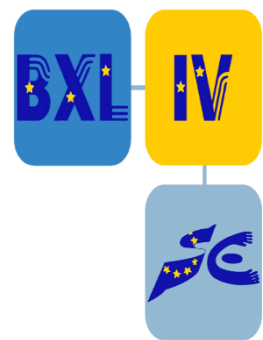
A specific course of common practice for instruments will be added: orchestra (**A11-W, A11-S**). It will be taught by the school music teachers.

# Choice of the instrument

- Each pupil selects 3 instruments he/she sorts by order of preference.
- Priority given to pupils who already play an instrument and who already have their own instrument.
- Priority given to pupils who commit to bring their own instrument.



# Condition for participation

- Commitment to participate in the project during **3 school years**. **Once you have chosen the music project you must stay in the “project music group” during s1-s3**
- The school may provide instruments on loan but the pupils and their families must commit themselves to keep good care of the instruments. They are also responsible in case of loss, theft (both inside and outside the school premises) and (non-) intentional damages.



# Number of places

The number of places is **limited**.  
Maximum 3 groups (1 wind, 1  
strings and 1 choir)

Places are allocated according to  
the **date of registration**.
